The Rotary Club of Bournemouth North invite all Left-handed Golfers to take part in the "SOUTHPAW OPEN" Golf Day, The Charity Tournament is supporting the Bournemouth "WINTON STROKE CLUB" which is part of the Winton Salvation Army community centre named "The Place Next Door", Volunteers collect members by mini bus and cars once a week for lunch followed by various forms of entertainment.

The Tournament will take place at Canford Magna Golf Club, Knighton Lane, Wimborne, Dorset. which is situated in 350 acres of beautiful Dorset countryside. The Parkland course is a challenging 6496 yard 18 hole course, with its natural parkland habitat graced with many species of birds and wildlife.

Stanley Webb President Elect of The Rotary Club quoted that the 2008 Tournament was a huge success with competitors taking part from local golf clubs, also travelling from Wareham ,Weymouth, Milton Keynes, Oxford, Taunton, Portsmouth, Fareham and Winchester.

Entry Fee is £45 per person or £160 a team of four. Fee includes coffee and bacon bap on arrival 18 holes of golf, followed by a rolling evening meal with presentation of prizes, and a raffle draw. Prizes for individual Stableford scores for men and ladies and in addition prizes for the team with the best two scores added together.

All competitors must present a handicap certificate from their home club on the tournament day. Maximum handicap for men is 28 and 36 for ladies.
